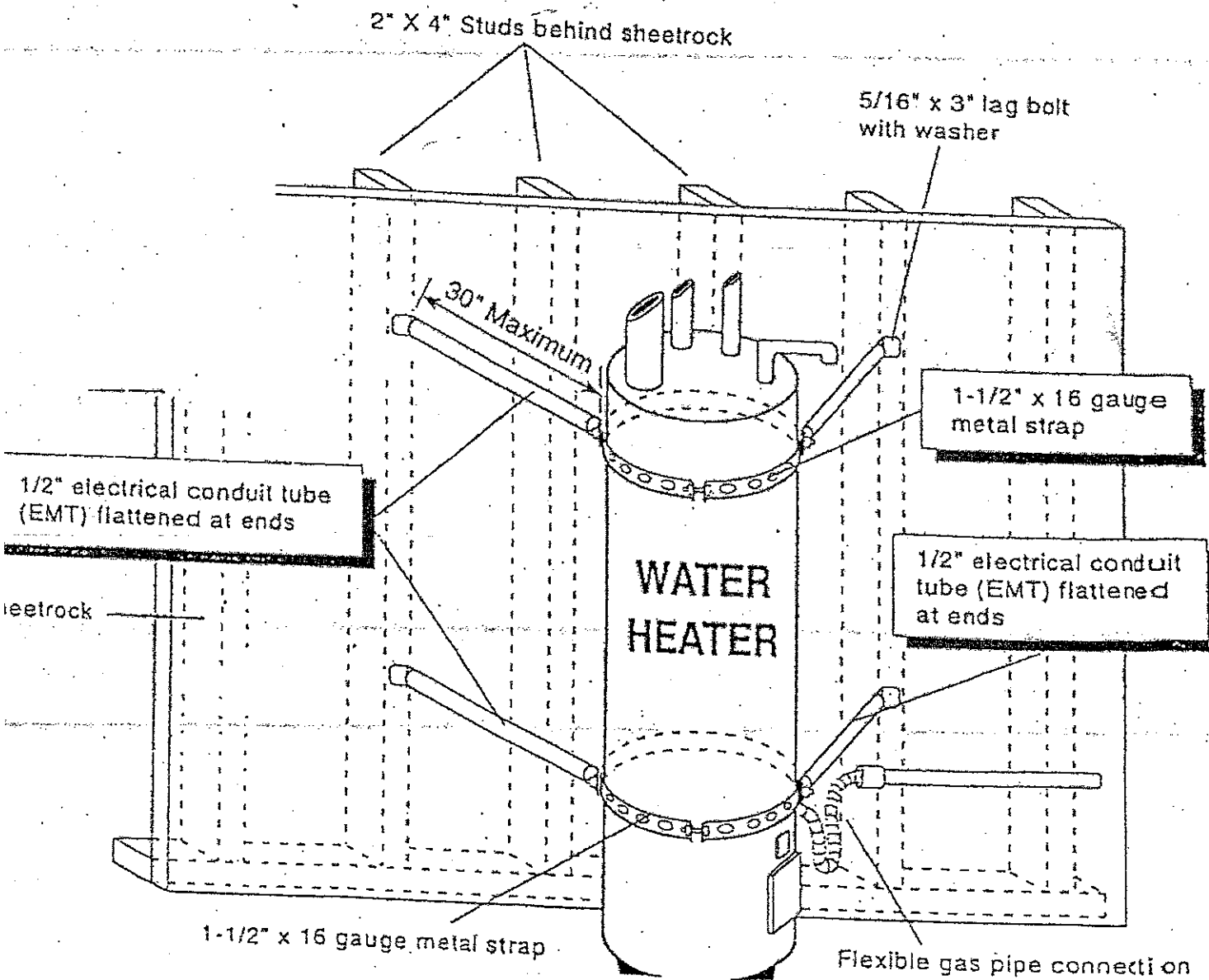
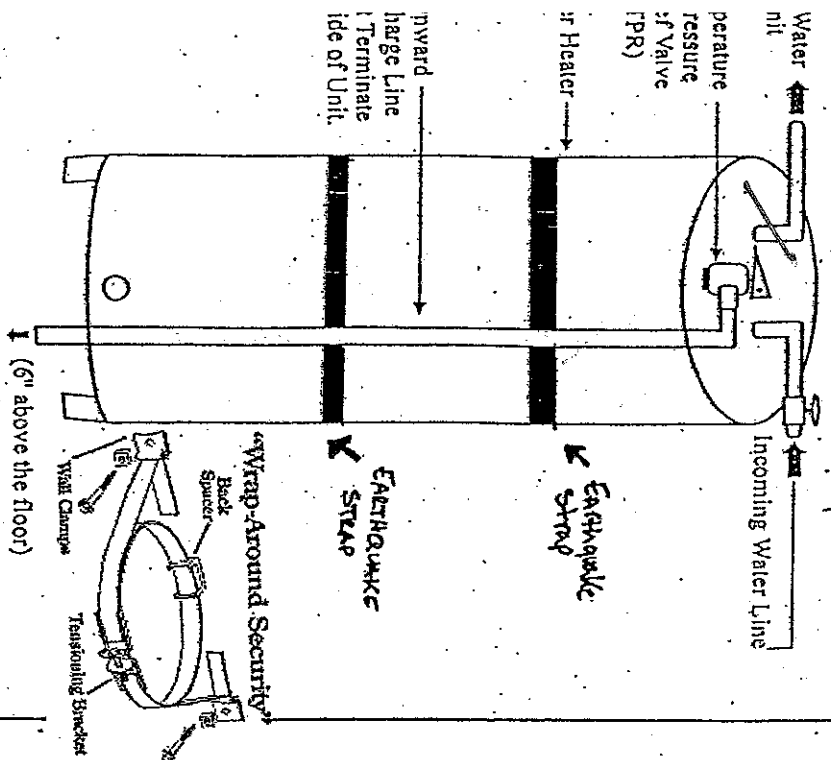

## TEMPERATURE AND PRESSURE RELIEF VALVE

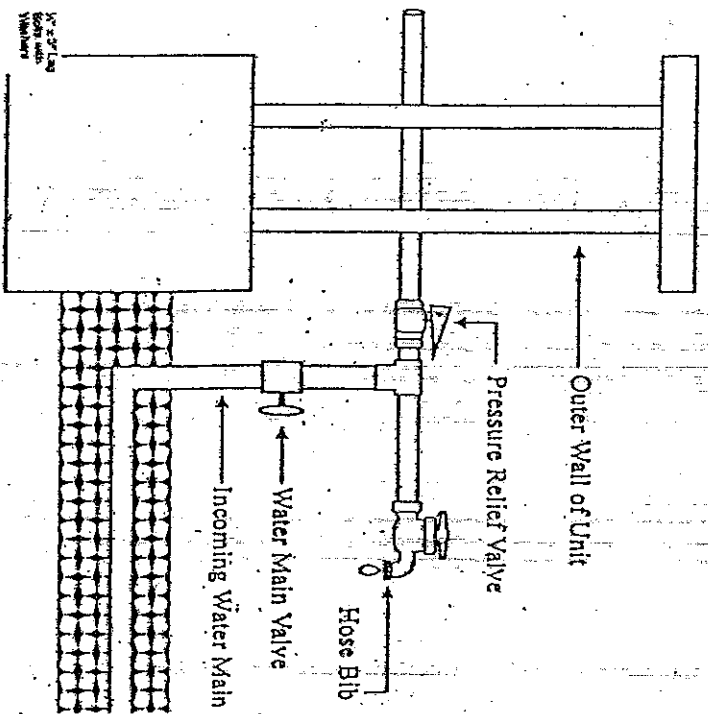


TPR (Temperature Pressure Relief) Valve MUST be utilized on a water heater DOES NOT have an ECO (Energy Cut-Off) device built into it. Most heaters over 15 years of age DO NOT have an ECO Device built in.

## NEED EARTHQUAKE STRAPS?

The Uniform Plumbing Code (UPC), section 510.5 says "In seismic zones 3 and 4, water heaters shall be anchored or strapped to resist horizontal displacement due to earthquake motion. Strapping shall be at points within the upper one-third (1/3) and lower one-third (1/3) of its vertical dimensions. At the lower point, a minimum of four (4) inches (102mm) shall be maintained above the controls with the strapping."

## PRESSURE RELIEF VALVE



NOTE: Pressure Relief Valve MUST be between Water Main Valve and Outer Wall.

The PR (Pressure Relief) Valve may be used in lieu of a TPR Valve when the water heater has an ECO Device built in. Usually heaters under 15 years of age have an ECO Device built in.
